CLOTHING & ACCESSORIES LIST FOR GIRLS

ALL GIRLS MUST HAVE AND WEAR CORRECTLY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OF CLOTHING:

Dailywear

- a navy blue fleece-lined regulation school jacket
- a school scarf
- a school tie
- two navy blue v-neck pullovers with the school crest (*available at the school from Sarah Bill*)
- a school blazer (*1st Year boarders compulsory and optional for mid-stream boarders*)
- a school skirt (*below knee length minimum*)
- 'Girls school blouse' - white or blue - shirt collar (*short sleeved shirts for summer wear*)
- navy blue, knee-length socks or navy blue, opaque tights
- plain, standard, flat, black leather shoes or black/navy leather deck shoes (*boots, canvas, runners, twin colour, slingbacks, platforms, heels greater than 5 cm, etc. not acceptable*)

Boarder and day pupil girls must have a white shirt and a school skirt for formal wear.

Optional informal uniform for Boarders (None of these items may be worn during class hours)

- blue school T-shirt (*available from Amprosports*)
- a school 'hoodie' (*available from Amprosports*)

Sportswear (*supplied by Amprosports, see school website*)

- school tracksuit bottoms (Gilbert) crested
- school training top (Gilbert) crested
- school hoodie (Gilbert) crested (optional)
- school hockey skirt (Grays) crested
- school hockey top (Grays) crested
- two pairs of school hockey socks (Grays) crested
- school PE top (Gilbert) crested
- school navy gym shorts (Gilbert) crested
- school navy base layers (optional)
- navy leggings (Grays) crested (optional)
- school tee shirt (Gilbert) (optional)
- school white polo & shorts (Gilbert/Grays) for tennis/cricket (optional)
- cricket whites (for team members)
- a pair of runners (white/non-marking soles only permitted in Sports Hall)
- swimwear, swimcap (to be worn in pool at all times) and flip-flops
- school holdall crested (optional)
- school basketball shorts (*available at the school from Sarah Bill*)

General Accessories

- towels (*light weight*)
- hockey stick (*first two terms*)
- tennis racquet (*summer term*)
- small good quality padlock - two for boarders (*combination locks not suitable*)
- a gum shield
- a pair of shin guards

For Boarders

- a bag for soiled clothes (*net bags for underwear are not permitted; laundry pins may be purchased at the school*)
- in purchasing shirts, underwear, night clothes, etc. please bear in mind that laundry is done once a week
- duvet and covers (*the school provides sheets, a pillow and pillowcases*)
- informal school uniform may be worn after class in the afternoons and evenings
- casual clothes may be worn only in free time at weekends (*the school reserves the right to decide what is acceptable*)

General Comments

Jewellery is limited to one pair of small stud earrings.

ALL BOYS MUST HAVE AND WEAR CORRECTLY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OF CLOTHING:

Dailywear
