Dear Parents and Guardians

As we prepare for the remainder of the students' return to in-school learning we need to receive confirmation of the dates of return or who is staying in school, in order to arrange staff and catering over the Easter holidays.

After you read down the options below please fill out this [GOOGLE FORM](#) and return no later than **Monday March 15th at 1pm**, to let us know the following:

- a. Is your child continuing to stay in the school or going to a host family for Easter?
- b. Is your child flying home at Easter? If so when do they return?
- c. If they have not returned to Ireland yet, are they coming for the Easter Camp or for the 5-day quarantine period?
- d. If they have been staying in a host family, are they returning for the Easter Camp or coming back on Sunday April 11th?

ALL TRAVEL INFORMATION MUST BE INPUT TO BOARDINGWARE, AND ALL TRAVEL QUESTIONS EMAILED TO OVERSEASTRAVEL@THEKINGHOSPITAL.IE.

If students do not return to the school campus when in-school learning resumes, we can no longer provide remote learning. However, students can still access assignments via Google Classroom. If a student cannot attend school due to a Covid-related illness or vulnerability, there are staff members assigned to assist those students.

RETURN TO THE SCHOOL CAMPUS

1. **If a student has not yet returned to Ireland and wishes to resume in-class learning from April 12th, the following applies:**

Students must return to KH by **April 6th** with a negative PCR test, quarantine in a single room for 5 days, and have a negative day 5 PCR test after quarantine, to resume in-person classes. Students arriving later than April 6th will have to make other quarantine arrangements with their guardian.

The charge for a 5-day quarantine is €250, which includes a stay in an individual room, all meals, supervision, activities, access to the medical centre and airport transfers. It does not include the cost of the PCR test. This is a government requirement to exit quarantine.

2. **Boarding remains open for Easter Break**

The school will remain open during the Easter Break for International students, who do not have family in Ireland, but they can also go out to a host family in Ireland, provided they return with a negative PCR test, the cost of which will be rebated to them.

The charge for the 2-week Easter Camp is €600, which includes all meals, supervision, activities, and access to the medical centre.

3. Returning from a host family

An International student that is currently in a host family in Ireland, may return earlier than April 11th but must contact [Cormac UaBrudair](#) to arrange in advance, and arrive with a negative PCR test. The cost of this PCR test will be rebated, as it is a school requirement to the health and safety of our students and staff. Students will be charged pro-rata for the time they are here over the Easter break.
