



FEE INFORMATION 2021/2022

BASIC FEES

E.U. student fees include a development levy of 20% (The development levy forms part of the school's fund-raising campaign). Fees are payable half yearly in advance on or before the first day of term in August and January each year. The preferred method is by way of Electronic Funds Transfer to the school bank account.

Non E.U. student fees include a surcharge of 25%. Fees are payable yearly in advance on or before the 1st August. The preferred method is by way of Electronic Funds Transfer to the school bank account.

Overseas students have the option of participating in the school's 'Overseas Travel Scheme' which offers supervised travel to / from the airport at the official school opening / closure dates for an additional charge. The King's Hospital School is not responsible for the travel arrangements of students who do not participate in this scheme. Full information on the scheme will be provided at a later date.

FAMILY DISCOUNTS

The school offers a discount to those families with more than one child concurrently in the school. The discount is currently 5% of the basic yearly fee for the second child, 10% of the basic yearly fee for the third and fourth child and 15% of the basic yearly fee for the 5th child.

INCIDENTAL CHARGES

The basic fee as above covers most general 'extra' expenses, for example, routine medical attention on-site and travelling to games within the Dublin area, etc.

There are certain additional charges which are added to the fee account each year. These include:

Personal Accident Insurance

This is a mandatory policy covering routine medical expenses following accidents to students, with a sum insured of €30,000.00 per student per claim. The policy is limited to payment of medical and dental expenses not recoverable from any other policy of insurance or any other health or personal accident insurer.

In the event of an accident resulting in medical expenses you may download a claim form from www.allianz.ie which should be completed and returned to the Insurers with supporting documentation within 30 days. In the event of an emergency, any major medical expenses incurred, on your behalf, by the school will be charged to you for immediate repayment. Please note that the onus is on Parents to apply for and return the completed claim forms. A mandatory charge of €15 per annum is included on the Winter fee invoice issued in July each year.

School Fees Remission Scheme

This is an optional scheme whereby school fees are insured against absence through sickness for more than four consecutive days (boarders) and five consecutive days (day students). For further information on the scheme please review '*SFRS Policy Information Winter 2020*'. If you do not wish to avail of this charge a written instruction confirming same must be provided to the school within 30 days of receipt of the fee invoice.

An optional charge of €130 for 7 day boarders, €116 for 5 day boarders and €56 for day students is included on each half yearly fee invoice issued in July and December each year.

Bluecoat Magazine

An annual publication recording the sporting, academic and general events of the school year provided to each student at a cost of €25, per annum, per family. Further details of the charge will be provided at a later date.

Parents Association

This is a charge for annual membership of The King's Hospital School Parent's Association. *If you do not wish to avail of this charge a written instruction confirming same must be provided to the school within 30 days of receipt of the fee invoice.* A charge of €25 per annum, per family, is included on the Spring fee invoice issued in December each year.

KHPPU

This is a charge for 5 year membership of The King's Hospital School Past Students Union and is only charged to 6th Year students in their final year at the school. *If you do not wish to avail of this charge a written instruction confirming same must be provided to the school prior to the Easter in which the student leaves.* A charge of €100, per 6th Year student, is included on their final Winter fee invoice issued in July each year.

Transition Year (TY)

This is a mandatory contribution of €225 which will be applied to the fee account in December and July. This fee contributes to the additional expenses incurred in Transition Year such as the Kilarity trip, the end of year trip and the weekly excursions and tours.

Games

Students taking part in all games fixtures outside the Dublin area will be charged a contribution to the cost of transport and accommodation.

General

Any additional costs incurred by the school on behalf of the student will be allocated to the fee account as they are incurred and are due for payment with the basic school fee. These can include photos, school day trips, supplementary texts/materials, external exam fees, etc.

LUNCHES / TEAS FOR DAY STUDENTS

A pre-paid cashless pin system is available for parents of day students who wish to have their child(ren) avail of lunch or tea. An online account must be set up for each student and payments are made online. For further details of the system please review '*Lunch Payment System*'. Full information on the scheme will be provided at a later date.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school offers a wide variety of extra-curricular activities including music, drama, pottery, etc to students, some of which incur an extra charge. The fees are designed simply to cover the cost to the school of these teachers' salaries. An extra-curricular pack will be forwarded to all parents during the summer break. Parents wishing to have their children avail of any of these activities should ensure the appropriate application forms, including payment, are then returned to the school as soon as possible. An information day/evening on the programme will also be held in September for students and parents. For further information on the activities offered please review '*Extra-curricular*'.
