We appreciate that there is a great deal of uncertainty around the state examinations at this juncture, however, as we have not heard otherwise from the Department of Education we feel it best to proceed as normal.

As such, we wish to inform you that the State Examinations Commission has issued a letter regarding the 2020 Payment of Examination Fees or making an application for a Medical Card exemption. The school will be posting these letters to you today.

Each individual letter will contain the information required to log onto the SEC on-line Fees Portal i.e. Exam number, Password and School Details.

Please note the closing date for the payment of Examination Fees or making an application for a Medical Card exemption is 30th April 2020.

[Medical Cards must be valid on 30th April 2020, GP Cards are not accepted.]

Once payment has been made candidates **MUST** present their receipt as proof of payment to the school via email – r.shaw@thekingshospital.ie

Please note that the school is not responsible should a candidate's fee not be paid in full. Consequences regarding non-payment are clearly outlined in SEC letter.
